## WIC

- Visits started at Menard in February 2025
- 142 different participants
- Current caseload roughly 120
- Decrease due to children aging out at age 5, moms that fully formula feed stop receiving benefits at 6 months postpartum, several foster children had a change in placement and families moving out of the area.
- Participants are from Ashland, Athens, Cantrall, Greenview, Loami, Oakford, Petersburg, Pleasant Plains, Riverton, Rushville (I offered to help her switch to Schuyler County, but she wanted to stay with us throughout her pregnancy then transition to them after she delivers; lived in Petersburg when she started with me), Springfield and Tallula.

## Outreach

- Mid- September 126 letters were mailed to WIC eligible households in Menard County that had a child under the age of 5 with an active Title XIX Medicaid; 12 new clients from letters.
